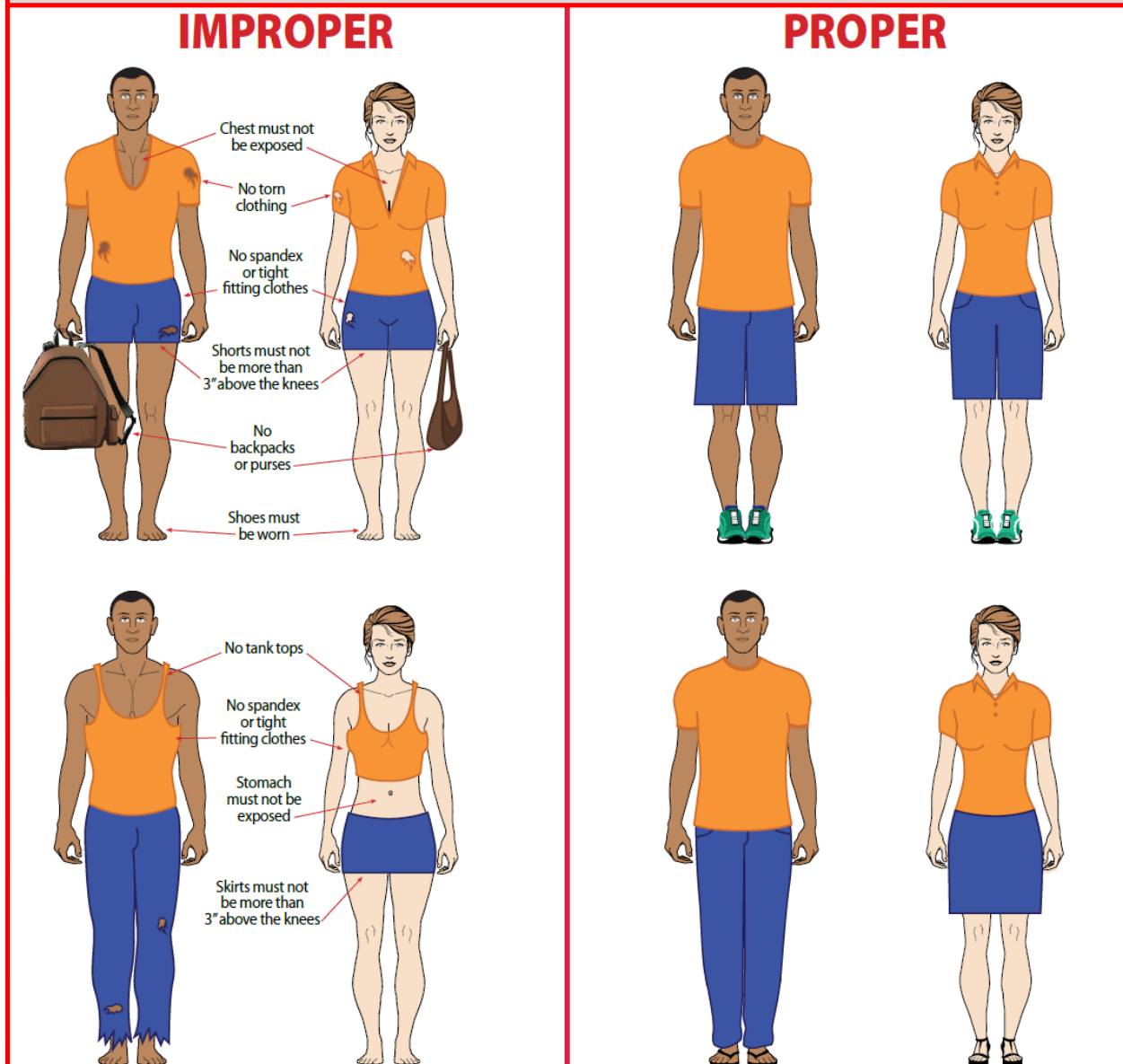




BAKER COUNTY DETENTION CENTER VISITOR DRESS CODE



Limits on the clothing allowed in the visitation area were designed to prevent harassment, discomfort or embarrassing incidents that may spoil your visit. Listed below are examples of proper and improper attire. Suggestive clothing and see-through fabrics will not be allowed. Appropriate underclothing is required. If you do not understand a rule or guideline, please feel free to ask a member of the staff for assistance.



Visitors wearing coats, jackets, sweaters, etc. must be wearing shirt that is proper under these items.

Visitors MUST adhere to the dress code policy. Visitors cannot wear:

1. Shirts without sleeves.
2. Low cut or revealing shirts, tanks/halter tops, stretch pants, leggings, tights, or Spandex pants.
3. Swimsuits, see-through, or torn clothing.
4. Short-shorts, miniskirts, hats, scarves, bandanas, or sun visors.
5. Clothing with profane pictures or language.
